

# Americans' Opinions on the Elimination of Rebates in Medicare Part D



**71%**  
of seniors



## A strong majority of seniors are very concerned

that implementing the Administration's Rebate Rule to eliminate rebates in Medicare Part D will cost seniors and taxpayers but provide a \$40 billion windfall to the pharmaceutical industry.

Seniors are particularly concerned that eliminating rebates in Medicare Part D could raise their out-of-pocket costs.

**3 in 4**

senior voters surveyed (75%) say they are very concerned about its potential to raise their out-of-pocket costs.



An overwhelming majority of seniors report increased Medicare Part D premiums would hurt them financially.



## 85% of seniors

said that increasing Medicare Part D premiums would have an impact on their personal financial situation.

Twice as many voters oppose as support eliminating rebates in Medicare Part D. Once voters learned more, their concerns increased.
