## Lansing: Protect Patients, Don't Raise Rx Drug Costs

Michigan lawmakers are considering a bill that could put patients at risk and raises drug costs.

HB 4348 will add new fees to prescriptions costs and strip away tools that employers and unions use to keep drug costs low.

## WHAT WOULD BE THE EFFECT OF HB 4348 IF SIGNED?



Adding an estimated \$10.80 fee at the pharmacy counter to every single prescription filled



Raise prescription drug spending by \$535 million in Michigan in the first year alone



Drive all prescription drug spending in Michigan \$6.6 billion higher over the next 10 years



Limit patient safety measures that ensure pharmacies handle medications appropriately and put patients at risk

Lansing: Protect patients and keep costs down.

Don't take away the tools that keep patients safe and prescription drugs affordable.
