



- Americans pay **\$11,938.32** per year¹
- Canadians pay **\$3,607.31** per year²



- Americans pay **\$16,313.28** per month³
- Germans pay around **\$6,000** per month⁴

- Japanese pay **\$55.42** per tablet⁶
