Raise prescription drug costs by more than **\$1,000 per person per year.**



Drive up health care premiums by \$491 million, making it difficult for businesses and unions to negotiate lower prescription drug costs.



Impact pharmacy benefits for the **83% of union households** that are highly concerned about policies by **increasing the amount they pay for prescription drugs.**



Significantly restrict employers' ability to manage costs, jeopardizing nearly **\$30 billion in savings over 10 years.**
